Family members do **NOT** need to be financial dependents or living with the member to be eligible. An associate degree or 60 credit hours is required to enroll.

OCSEA Enrollment Checklist for CSU

1. Apply to Central State University

Please go to www.centralstate.edu then select "Apply Now" and select "Union Student" or <https://www.centralstate.edu/global/ApplyNow.php>

2. Check Union Education Trust (UET) Eligibility

As an OCSEA member, you may be eligible for vouchers up to \$4,000 per fiscal year through the Career Improvement Program (CIP) to attend Eastern Gateway. **You must utilize your Union Education Trust (UET) fund and you MUST apply for UET vouchers to attend.** For more information go to uedtrust.org. You can call 1-800-969-4702, Ext. 2645 or email support@uedtrust.org to confirm your eligibility for UET. Upon enrollment, Free College will assist you in preparing your voucher applications.

3. Complete the Free Application for Federal Financial Aid (FAFSA) Studentaid.gov
