## OCSEA Enrollment Checklist

1. Begin the process of applying to Eastern Gateway Community College by going to **OCSEAEducation.org** and filling out the interest form.
2. Apply online to the Eastern Gateway Community College at **egcc.edu**.
3. If you are an OCSEA bargaining unit State of Ohio employee, you must utilize your **Union Education Trust (UET)** funds first. You can call **1-800-969-4702, ext. 2645** or email **blowe@ocsea.org** to confirm your eligibility for UET. You are eligible for vouchers up to \$3,500 per fiscal year through the Career Improvement Program (CIP) to attend Eastern Gateway. If you exhaust your UET funds, then you will need to complete a Federal Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). See Step 3 for details. For more information go to **uedtrust.org**.
4. Complete the online FAFSA application for federal financial aid:
