#### ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for these scholarships, interested students must apply for federal financial aid and use any grants to pay the tuition. They must also use any employer sponsored tuition assistance, such as Union Education Trust. Any remaining balance for tuition, fees, or books at EGCC will be covered by the scholarship. This ensures that no student has to pay out-of-pocket for any tuition or fees at EGCC—resulting in cost savings of thousands of dollars!

1. Begin the process of applying to Eastern Gateway Community College by going to **OCSEAEducation.org** and filling out the interest form.
2. Apply online to the Eastern Gateway Community College at **egcc.edu**.
3. If you are an OCSEA bargaining unit State of Ohio employee, you must utilize your **Union Education Trust (UET)** funds first **and you must apply for UET vouchers to attend**. You can call **1-800-969-4702, ext. 2645** or email **blowe@ocsea.org** to confirm your eligibility for UET. You are eligible for vouchers up to \$4,000 per fiscal year through the Career Improvement Program (CIP) to attend Eastern Gateway. If you exhaust your UET funds, then you will need to complete a Federal Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). See Step 4 for details. For more information go to **uedtrust.org**.
4. Complete the online FAFSA application for federal financial aid:

Note: The U.S. Department of Education may require further verification.
5. Submit official high school transcript, or official GED test score to to:
