You can call 1-800-969-4702 , ext. 2645 or email blowe@ocsea.org to confirm your eligibility for UET. You are eligible for vouchers up to \$4,000 per fiscal year through the Career Improvement Program (CIP) to attend Eastern Gateway. If you exhaust your UET funds, then you will need to complete a Federal Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). See Step 4 for details. For more information go to uedtrust.org .
