ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for these scholarships, interested students must apply for federal financial aid and use any grants to pay the tuition, fees and books. They must also use any employer sponsored tuition assistance, such as Union Education Trust. Any remaining balance for tuition, fees, or books at EGCC will be covered by the scholarship. This ensures that no student has to pay out-of-pocket for any tuition or fees at EGCC—resulting in cost savings of thousands of dollars!

- 1. Apply online to the Eastern Gateway Community College**
Go to egcc.edu/admission/union (Choose the union student option)

- 2. Check Union Education Trust (UET) Eligibility**
As an OCSEA member, you may be eligible for vouchers up to \$4,000 per fiscal year through the Career Improvement Program (CIP) to attend Eastern Gateway. **You must utilize your Union Education Trust (UET) fund and you MUST apply for UET vouchers to attend.** For more information go to uedtrust.org. You can call **1-800-969-4702, Ext. 2645** or email support@uedtrust.org to confirm your eligibility for UET. Upon enrollment, Free College will assist you in preparing your voucher applications.

- 3. Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)***

- 4. Submit transcripts: High School and College (if any)**
Submit your high school transcript or GED test score as proof of high school completion. Official transcripts must be sent directly from the school to:

* If you are unsure how to get your official high school transcript, contact your enrollment advisor for assistance. If you cannot find the ETS code for your school(s), please search by city and/or state only. Or Enter "Other High School" on Institution name then click search and click on Other High School.

If you have completed any college coursework, have the transcript sent to EGCC for review. Applicable college credits may be transferred to the new program.

Please Note: *If you already have a college degree, a copy of your high school diploma or transcript is not required. Other than that, ALL applicants are required to provide a copy of their high school diploma or transcript; the option of sending college records are then optional and must be official. Students who have not yet obtained a college degree and submit college records only, will not be eligible to register until their high school records are processed.*
