The RN to BSN degree program is 100% online for any Registered Nurse who has their associate degree. While the RN to BSN degree isn't free, tuition is \$200 per credit hour, making it one of the lowest cost programs of its kind in the country.

BSN Admission Requirements

All applicants to the Franklin University RN to BSN program must meet ALL the following admission requirements:

- **Be a graduate of an associate nursing degree or diploma in a registered nursing program.**
- **Hold a current and unencumbered RN license in the United States.**
- **Be a dues-paying OCSEA member (or retiree) or extended family member of an OCSEA dues-paying member (or retiree).**

OCSEA Enrollment Checklist

1. Begin the process of applying to Franklin University by going to **OCSEAEducation.org.franklin-university-bsn** and filling out the interest form.
2. Complete the online FAFSA application for federal financial aid:
FAFSA Website: **fafsa.ed.gov**
Franklin University school code: **003046**
Note: The U.S. Department of Education may require further verification.
3. Apply online to Franklin University at **OCSEAEducation.org/franklin-university-bsn**.
4. If you are an OCSEA bargaining unit State of Ohio employee, you can utilize your **Union Education Trust (UET)** funds and you **can** apply for UET vouchers to attend. You can call **1-800-969-4702, ext. 2645** or email **blowe@ocsea.org** to confirm your eligibility for UET. You are eligible for vouchers up to \$4,000 per fiscal year through the Career Improvement Program (CIP) to attend Franklin University. For more information go to **uedtrust.org**.
5. **Electronic transcripts**-Franklin University prefers electronic transcripts from other institutions and from third-party transcript providers. In both cases, electronic transcripts must be emailed from the provider directly to Franklin University.
