3. Apply online to Paul Quinn College at **OCSEAEducation.org/paul-quinn-college**.
4. Submit official high school transcript, or official GED test score electronically to: SRCsupport@pqc.edu or SRCtranscripts@pqc.edu.
5. Submit all official college transcripts to the email address above (**if applicable**).
